

El Bakry Scholarship

El Bakry Scholarship is a full-fee scholarship for New Generation's students. It has been created to provide our high school students with an education opportunity at the University of Prince Edward Island, Cairo Campus (UPEI, Cairo Campus) and the Toronto Metropolitan University, Cairo (TMU, Cairo) hosted by the Universities of Canada in Egypt (UCE).

El Bakry Scholarship is awarded every academic year to grade 12 students who comply with the relevant terms and conditions. Moreover, the scholarship applies to all the offered majors by both universities. The Scholarship aims to attract top high school students who do not only enjoy academic excellence, but also have special talents, leadership skills, innovative mindset, entrepreneurial spirit, community involvement, or any other capacities that would positively contribute to the development of Egypt.

Relevant terms and conditions:

- Minimum Average grade of 90%
- Submit letter of intent (800-1000 words)
- Must meet the admission requirements of the preferred program.

Admission Requirements for University of Prince Edward Island



- English Proficiency Requirements:
 - Academic IELTS (Overall score of 6.5 with 6.5 in writing no other band below 6) or
 - TOEFL Internet based Test (80 with a minimum of 20 in each category) or
 - English Proficiency Placement (Above 4.5) or
 - PTE (Pearson Test on English) (58 For all faculties)
- Admission Requirements
 - Program of Entrepreneurship: Grade 12 Math, English, Advanced Business, Economics, Psychology/ Sociology, Electives (Statistics, IT, Art/Music/PE); an overall average of 90% minimum.
 - Program of Computer Science & Mathematics: Grade 12 Advanced Math, English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Electives (Statistics, IT, Art/Music/PE); an overall average of 90% minimum.
 - Program of Sustainable Design Engineering: Grade 12 Advanced Math, English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Electives (Statistics, IT, Art/Music/PE); an overall average of 90% minimum.

Admission Requirements for Toronto Metropolitan University (Ryerson)

- English Proficiency Requirements:
 - International English Language Testing System (IELTS): 6.5 for all faculties or
 - Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) iBT: All Engineering Program (83) – Fashion, Media Production, and Sport Media (92) or
 - Pearson Test of English (PTE): 60 for all faculties

Requirements reflect overall scores. There are no minimum requirements for band scores (e.g. reading, writing, speaking, and listening).

All applicants, including those who must submit proof of English language proficiency, are required to present a senior-level English course. We will not accept the senior-level English course in lieu of a test of English language proficiency, with the exception of the qualifications listed below:
