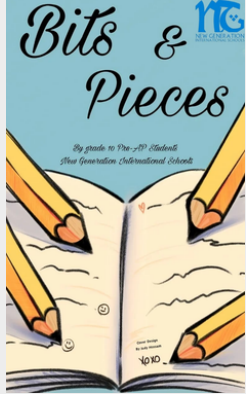


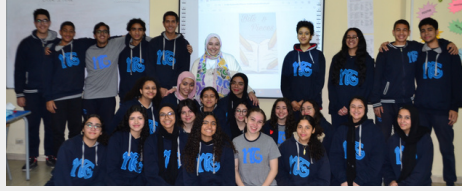
MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

May this holy month bless you and your loved ones with health, wellness, and happiness.



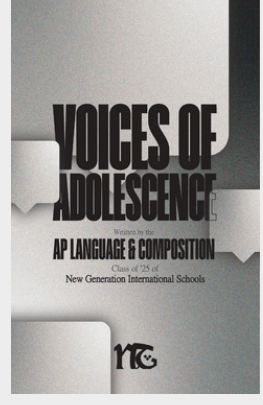
