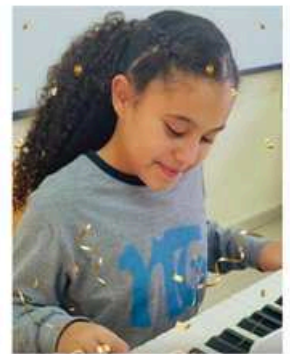


# NG ACADEMY



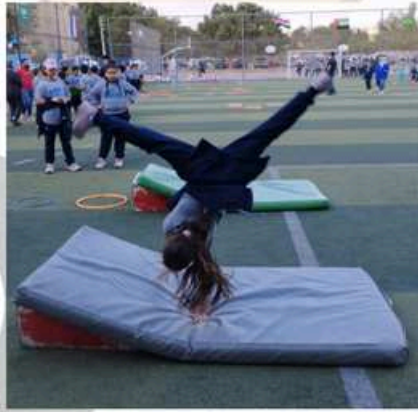
The NG Academy has been running successfully now for three consecutive years, five days a week, Sundays through Thursdays.

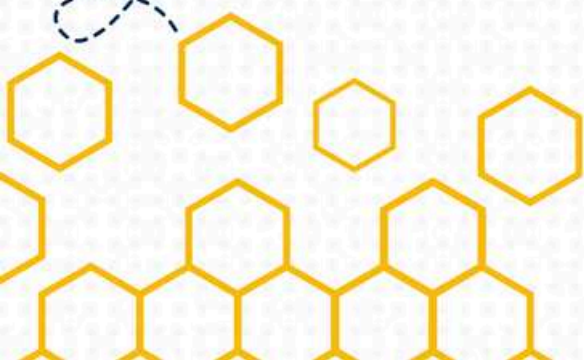




# SPELLING BEE

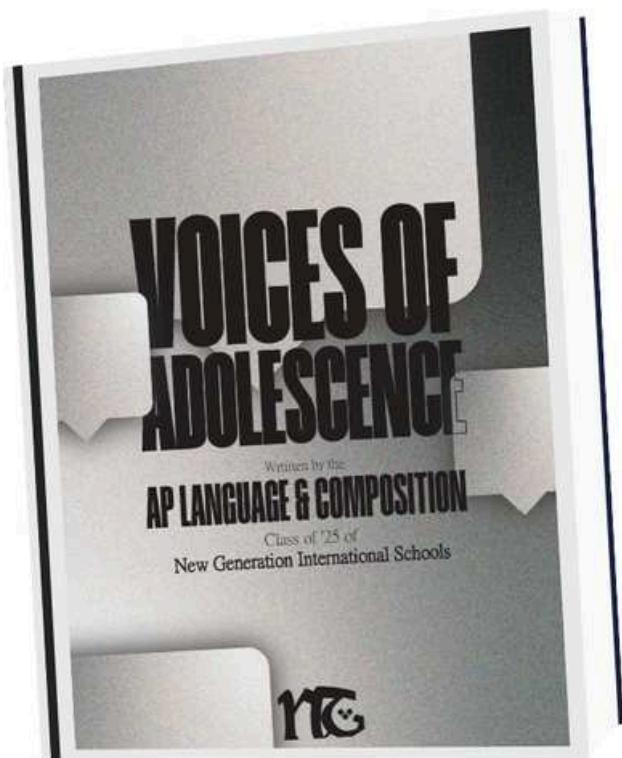
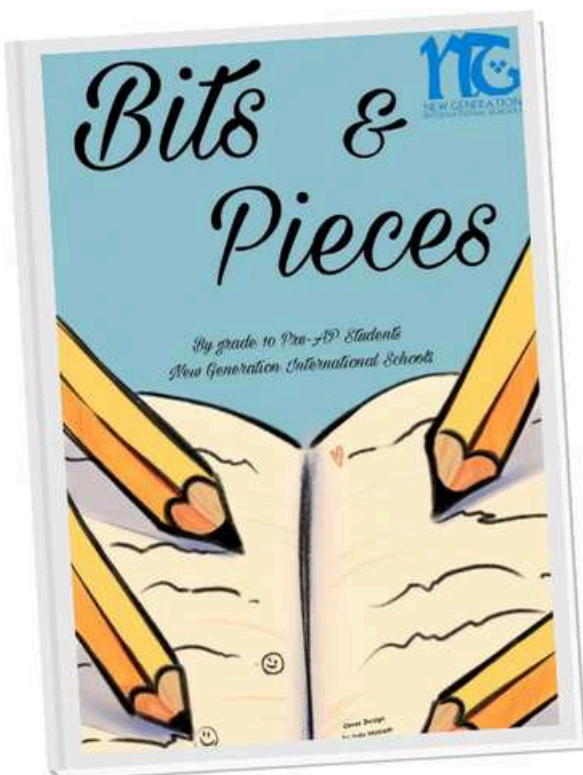




# AP BOOK

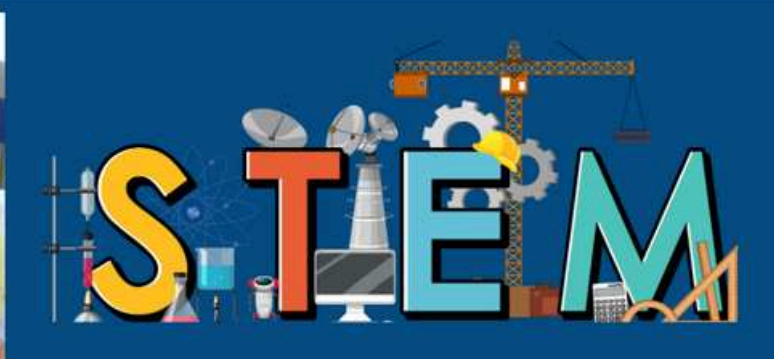




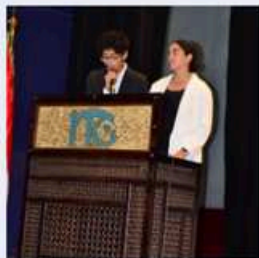


# STEAM Fair

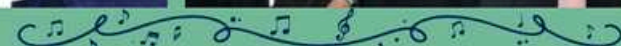

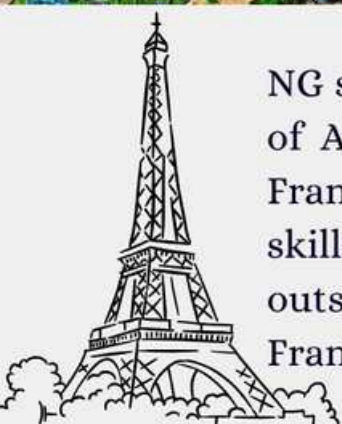
# INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL OF FRANCOPHONE SCHOOLS THEATRE

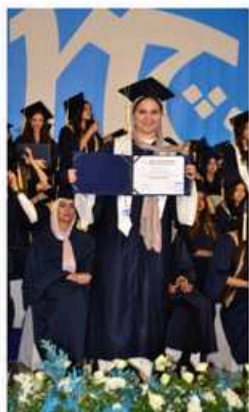
# GRADE 12 GRADUATION

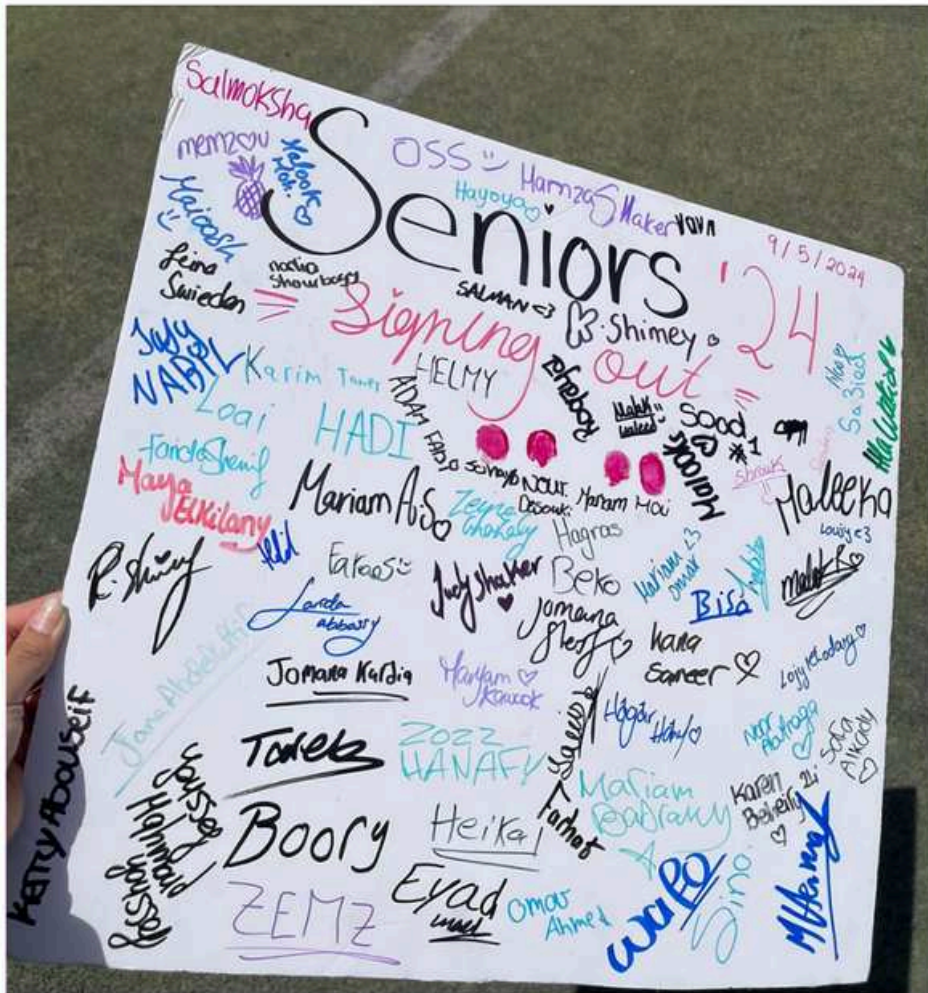
